Changing Nursing Graduate Students' Understanding of Social Determinants of Health

Dr. April L. Folgert is an associate professor in the School of Nursing at Concordia University Wisconsin. Her background includes practice in home healthcare for more than a decade. She has taught community and population health to undergraduate nursing students and integrates concepts of cultural competence across courses. More recently she led a group of graduate and undergraduate nursing students to Costa Rica to learn about social determinants of health throughout the country. Today she will share aspects of the course that influenced graduate nursing students' understanding of these critical concepts, recommendations for the future, and students' reflection on how they plan to promote health and healing for people impacted by injustice.
